

CUT IN REGLET 1" DEEP MIN. PRE-SATURATE EDGE OF JM PMMA SCRIM AND TUCK INTO REGLET. (THIS TECHNIQUE IS OPTIONAL AND IS FOR CONC./MASONRY ONLY. TYPICALLY TERMINATE JM PMMA FLASHING ON WALL SURFACE 8" HIGH.)

APPLY APPROPRIATE SEALANT CONTINUOUS ALONG TOP OF FLASHING (FOR REGLET INSTALLATION ONLY)

CLEAN & ABRASE LADDER STRINGERS PER SSPC-SP3

LADDER STRINGER WRAPPED WITH JM PMMA MEMBRANE AND EXTENDED ONTO ROOF MEMBRANE

ROOF LADDER ANCHORED TO BUILDING (BY OTHERS)

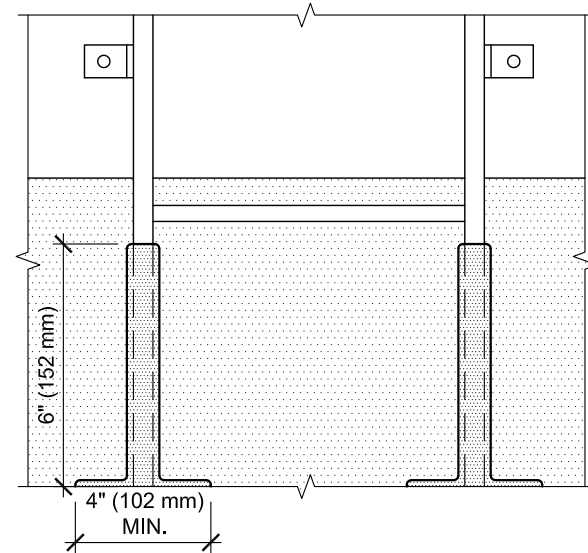
PREPARE, LEVEL & PATCH SUBSTRATE WITH JM PMMA REPAIR PASTE AFTER PRIMING & PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OF JM PMMA MEMBRANE

ENSURE FULL RESIN SATURATION OF JM PMMA SCRIM AND CONTACT WITH SUBSTRATE

JM PMMA MEMBRANE FLASHING EXTENDED 4" MIN. HORIZONTALLY ONTO PREPARED AND PRIMED FIELD MEMBRANE

ENSURE ALL MEMBRANE TERMINATIONS ARE ENCAPSULATED IN JM PMMA RESIN

BITUMINOUS FIELD MEMBRANE

5. ALL SEALANTS / CAULKING SHALL BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND MAINTAINED BY THE BUILDING OWNER THROUGHOUT THE LIFE OF THE ROOF.
