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Installation/Application Instructions

Apply when temperature is 45°F (7°C) and rising. Do Not Thin.

All surfaces must be swept clean and free from oil, grease, rust, scale, loose paint and dirt. Prime dusty or porous masonry, old roofs and all metal with a bituminous primer before applying the coating.

Stir in the container before applying. Apply with a good quality roof brush, long-napped roller or commercial grade spray equipment. Apply two coats. The first coat must be thoroughly dry before applying the second coat. The coating should not be applied when rain or frost is forecasted within 24 hours.

Precautions

Avoid prolonged contact with skin • Avoid contact with eyes • Do not take internally • Keep container closed when not in use • Keep out of reach of children.
