Johns Manville strives to identify, attract, and develop long-term partnerships with diverse business enterprises that undergo a review and certification process to ensure the diverse suppliers are certified minority, women, U.S. military veteran or service-disabled veteran, LGBTQ, disability-owned, or small or disadvantaged businesses.

To become a certified diverse supplier, please review the guidelines and certification requirements below.

Certifying Agencies for Diverse Suppliers

To qualify as a diverse supplier for RFX opportunities with Johns Manville, the supplier must have a valid certification from a third-party certifying agency acceptable to Johns Manville.
